The Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Bureau of Fire Services will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, July 29, 2014, at the Secondary Complex, General Office Building (GOB), Conference Room A, at 7150 Harris Dr., Dimondale, Michigan 48813. The hearing will be held to receive public comments on proposed changes to the Administrative Rules for Health Care Facilities Fire Safety.

The proposed rules will adopt the 2012 edition of the Life Safety Code (NFPA 101) upon which the current Health Care Facilities Fire Safety rules are based, and to reflect "recognized good practice as evidenced by standards adopted by nationally recognized authorities in the field of fire protection," as mandated by 1941 PA 207.

These rules are promulgated by authority conferred on the Bureau of Fire Services by 1941 PA 207. These rules will take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
