This notice is being provided pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 ("WARN"). Latcha and Associates, L.L.C. recently suffered the loss of one its most significant customer accounts.

In response to this significant downturn in business, Latcha and Associates, L.L.C. has been forced to immediately undergo a company-wide restructuring, which will result in a mass layoff at its Farmington Hills facility located at 24600 Hallwood Court, Farmington Hills, MI 48335. This mass layoff is expected to be permanent.

Effective January 24, 2020, Latcha and Associates, L.L.C. notified all affected employees of their upcoming separation date and that their separation from employment will be permanent. The affected employees are expected to be separated from employment on March 31, 2020, with all separations accomplished on that same date.
