Dear Ms. Petrik,

Thanks for inviting me to provide suggestions on proposed revisions to rules regarding the Unemployment Insurance Agency Appeals Commission. As such, I provide the following suggested rule change:

R 792.11423

Allow any party, represented or not and without consent of the other involved party and without consent of the Commission, to file a written argument (brief) regarding an appeal to the Commission. The deadline for filing an appeal must be submitted no later than 30 days after the mailed date of the notice of receipt of appeal. Matters involving oral argument under R 792.11423 would go unchanged.

This change would be consistent with the appeal rights of a party in unemployment appeal matters before a Circuit Court.

I request that my previous submission be withdrawn and taken down from the website. I further give approval to publish this statement on the website.
