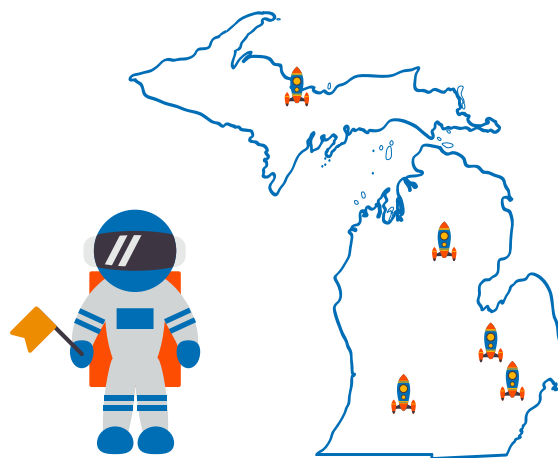
100% of participants said they learned something from the training.
