

**LIBRARY OF MICHIGAN
SCHOOL LIBRARY WORKGROUP**

- CHARGE:** To meet with Library of Michigan staff to discuss issues regarding Michigan school libraries and the resources available from the Library of Michigan, and to review the Michigan School Libraries for the 21st Century program measures (www.michigan.gov/sl21).
- TERMS:** 2 years or 3 years, depending on availability
A member can serve up to two terms
- SCHEDULE:** Two meetings a year, as needed. Both meetings in the summer at dates acceptable to the majority of the group.
- MEETINGS:** Meetings will be held at the Library of Michigan. The first meeting will discuss current Michigan school library issues and resources. The second meeting will be to review and revise, if necessary, the Michigan School Libraries for the 21st Century program measures or to discuss other issues as needed.
- MEMBERSHIP:** Membership will include Library of Michigan staff, Michigan Association of Media in Education leadership, and a representative from a Michigan School of Library Science as well as school librarians from around the state. When possible, the Library of Michigan will attempt to be geographically diverse in the membership. Maximum membership is ten, excluding Library of Michigan staff and MAME leadership.
