Upon reviewing the record of the administrative proceedings in this matter, the Commission finds as follows:


FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Petitioner is or has been licensed as a law enforcement officer in Michigan.
2. Petitioner was subjected to an adjudication of guilt for an offense specified in Michigan Compiled Laws Section 333.7404(2)(a), by entry of a plea of guilty.
3. The adjudication of guilt was entered in conjunction with an order of probation under Michigan Compiled Laws Section 333.7411.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Commission is required to revoke Petitioner's Law Enforcement Officer License under subsection 9(12)(d)(ii) of the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards Act.

IT IS ORDERED THAT Petitioner's Law Enforcement Officer License is revoked, effective on the date below.
