### **CALL TO ORDER**

The Commission meeting was called to order by Chair Doreen Olko at 10:35 AM on June 12, 2013 at the MCOLES Office in Lansing.

### **INTRODUCTIONS**

Chair Olko introduced herself and asked the Commission members, staff, and audience to do the same.

## ACCEPTANCE OF THE APRIL 10, 2013 COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

A **MOTION** was made by Commissioner Mawer and supported by Commissioner Bosscher to approve the April 10, 2013 Commission meeting minutes with one deletion.

A **VOTE** was taken. The **MOTION** carried.

## ADDITIONS/CHANGES TO THE AGENDA

Chair Olko advised that MSP made a request to withdraw their academy proposal from consideration. Lt. Col. Atkinson acknowledged the request.

## CHAIR'S REPORT

Law Enforcement Officer Position Report – Chair Olko stated the electronic distribution contained the LEO report for the month of May. The number of law enforcement officers and positions showed a slight increase for the month.

Special Use Requests – Chair Olko stated that the commission materials contained a report detailing the Special Use Requests. There were no questions.

Chair Olko also advised that at the April meeting the Commission approved a Special Use Request (SUR) for Detroit PD. Detroit has since sent MCOLES an addendum to that SUR. They are requesting to send three additional officers to the training and this would increase the total on the request to \$9,145.00.

A **MOTION** was made by Commissioner Buczek and supported by Commissioner Calabrese to approve the change to Detroit Police Department's Special Use Request.

A **VOTE** was taken. The **MOTION** carried.

Grant Adjustment Requests – The Commissioners were advised that the Grant Adjustment Requests Activity Report was also part of the electronic distribution of Commission materials. There were no questions.

A **MOTION** was made by Commissioner Wendling and supported by Commissioner Grabowski to approve the Grant Adjustment Requests.

A **VOTE** was taken. The **MOTION** carried.

## **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Legislative Initiatives – Executive Director Harvey advised the Commission that the two bills, Senate Bill 411 and Senate Bill 412 were approved and moved quickly from Committee and are now going to the Senate. He advised he would forward a link to the Commissioners with information on the two bills.

IADLEST – Executive Director Harvey advised that he recently attended the IADLEST Conference in Portland, Oregon. He came back with the position of Second Vice-President and will be the Vice-President next year. The following year he should be voted in as the President. He stated he was very excited about the opportunities with this organization. He also said that the majority of the expenses from the trip were covered by IADLEST. The topic under discussion at the conference was funding. It appears that funding is a problem faced by everyone.

Law Enforcement Distribution (LED) – Director Harvey turned the meeting over to Ms. Hermina Kramp. Deputy Executive Director Kramp advised that the LED had been calculated and the figure was \$88.49 per full time equated MCOLES licensed officer. The amounts distributed per agency will be posted on the web.

Computers – Director Harvey stated that in the upcoming year we will be taking the Commission meetings on the road. The computers we are using are old and he would like to get away from using them. He asked anyone who is able to download the information on their personal laptop, iPad, or tablet to do so. Paper copies of the material will also be available.

Chair Olko congratulated Director Harvey on behalf of the Commission for his election to Second Vice-President of IADLEST. She stated that in the Strategic Plan it was decided that they want Director Harvey to be a leader and felt that IADLEST was one way to accomplish this goal.

Chair Olko introduced Lt. Darin Szilagy of the Detroit Police Department. She then read into record Commission Resolution 2013-03 Honoring Fallen Police Officer Charles Armour and Extend Public Safety Officer Benefits. Lt. Szilagy accepted the resolution on behalf of the Armour family and thanked the Commission.

A **MOTION** was made by Commissioner Weiler and supported by Commissioner Timpner to approve Commission Resolution 2013-03 Honoring Fallen Police Officer Charles Armour.

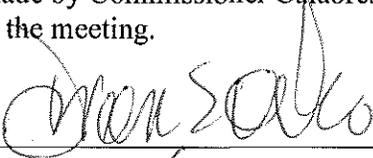

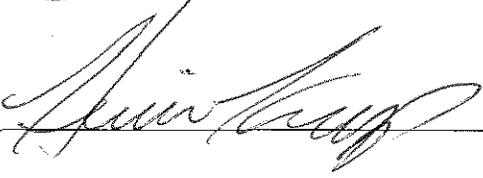
