

Commission Resolution 2014-06 Resolution to Honor Fallen Firefighter Nathaniel Fruin And Extend Public Safety Officer Benefits

WHEREAS, the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards is the duly appointed body of state government providing for the training and licensure of Michigan law enforcement officers; and,

WHEREAS, Firefighter Nathaniel Fruin began his career with the Mattawan Fire District as a cadet; and,

WHEREAS, Firefighter Nathaniel Fruin served as a volunteer fireman in the State of Michigan for a period of 4 years with the Mattawan Fire District; and,

WHEREAS, Firefighter Nathaniel Fruin was a public servant who was dedicated to preserving public safety and performing his duties in an exemplary manner; and,

WHEREAS, Firefighter Nathaniel Fruin, devoted to his family, was the son of Linda and Charles, brother to Sarah and Alex and left behind many more extended family members and co-workers; and

WHEREAS, Firefighter Nathaniel Fruin suffered a fatal cardiac event while responding to an emergency call for service involving a house fire; and,

WHEREAS, the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards, on behalf of all Michigan public safety officers, expresses profound sympathy to the family, fellow firefighters, friends, and loved ones of Nathaniel Fruin.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the members of the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards pay their highest tribute to the service and sacrifice of Firefighter Nathaniel Fruin; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all eligible benefits provided through the Public Safety Officer Benefits Act shall be extended to the survivors of Firefighter Nathaniel Fruin.
