

## Commission Resolution 2014-07 A Resolution to Honor Fallen Police Officer Patrick Hill And Extend Public Safety Officer Benefit

WHEREAS, the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards is the duly appointed body of state government providing for the training and licensure of Michigan law enforcement officers; and,

**WHEREAS**, Officer Patrick Hill began his law enforcement career after attending and graduating from the Detroit Police Metro Academy in 2001; and,

WHEREAS, Officer Patrick Hill served as a licensed officer in the State of Michigan for over 12 years and devoted his entire career to the Detroit Police Department; and,

**WHEREAS**, Officer Patrick Hill was a dedicated public servant who performed his duties in a manner that has brought honor to the entire law enforcement profession; and,

**WHEREAS**, Officer Patrick Hill demonstrated commitment and care in the exercise of his duties and was an eager protector of the public, demonstrated by his joining the Comprehensive Violence Reduction Partnership in 2012; and,

WHEREAS, Officer Patrick Hill was fatally wounded while attempting to apprehend a homicide suspect; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards, on behalf of all Michigan public safety officers, expresses profound sympathy to the family, fellow police officers, friends, and loved ones of Officer Patrick Hill.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the members of the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards pay their highest tribute to the service and sacrifice of Officer Patrick Hill; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all eligible benefits provided through the Public Safety Officer Benefits Act shall be extended to the survivors of Officer Patrick Hill.
