**Resolution to Honor**  
**Professor Janet E. Findlater**

*WHEREAS*, the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards is the duly appointed body of state government authorized to oversee and set standards for the basic training, in-service training, and licensure of Michigan law enforcement officers; and,

*WHEREAS*, Professor Janet E. Findlater of the Wayne State University Law School has been a dedicated collaborator with the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards in the effort to create a coordinated community response to domestic and sexual violence; and

*WHEREAS*, Professor Janet E. Findlater served as a member of the Domestic and Sexual Violence Prevention and Treatment Board appointed by the Governor during a critical time in the development of a coordinated community response including law enforcement professionals; and

*WHEREAS*, Professor Janet E. Findlater served as a co-chair of a cross-disciplinary task force empaneled to work toward ending violence against women through the creation of inter-disciplinary training; and

*WHEREAS*, Professor Janet E. Findlater also served as a co-chair, along with a member of the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards, of a task force responsible for creating and implementing the first statewide model domestic violence law enforcement response policy; and

*WHEREAS*, Professor Janet E. Findlater has been a dedicated mentor and educator to members of the law enforcement community and the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards, performing tasks in a manner that has brought honor to the Domestic and Sexual Violence Prevention and Treatment Board, Wayne State University and the teaching and law professions; and,

*WHEREAS*, Professor Janet E. Findlater is retiring after 40 years of dedicated teaching and public service;

*NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED*, that the members of the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards express profound appreciation and pay their highest tribute to the service of Professor Janet E. Findlater.
