Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards

*Commission Resolution 2018-09
Recognize and Extend Public Safety Officer Benefits to
Otsego County Sheriff's Deputy Amy Moon*

WHEREAS, the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards is the agency of the State of Michigan that sets standards for training and licensure of Michigan law enforcement officers and administers the Public Safety Officers Benefit Program; and,

WHEREAS, Deputy Amy Moon served honorably as a Deputy with the Otsego County Sheriff's Office; and,

WHEREAS, Deputy Amy Moon was a dedicated public servant who performed her duties in a manner that has brought honor to the entire law enforcement profession; and,

WHEREAS, Deputy Amy Moon's commitment to excellence was evidenced in her 15 years of service with the Otsego County Sheriff's Office; and,

WHEREAS, Deputy Amy Moon demonstrated commitment and care in the exercise of her duties and was an eager protector of the public and her fellow law enforcement officers; and,


WHEREAS, on November 30, 2014 Deputy Amy Moon was in her patrol vehicle policing an accident when an oncoming motorist lost control of the vehicle they were operating and struck Deputy Amy Moon's patrol car causing serious injury and a permanent and total disability to Deputy Amy Moon; and,

WHEREAS, the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards, on behalf of all Michigan public safety officers, would like to formally recognize Deputy Amy Moon's sacrifice and expresses our gratitude for her service; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the members of the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards pay their highest tribute to the service and sacrifice of Deputy Amy Moon and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all eligible benefits provided through the Public Safety Officer Benefits Act shall be extended to the Deputy Amy Moon.
