FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

Upon reviewing the record of the administrative proceedings in this matter, the Commission finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Petitioner is or has been licensed as a law enforcement officer in Michigan.
2. Petitioner was subjected to an adjudication of guilt for an offense specified in Michigan Compiled Laws, MCL750.81(A), Aggravated Assault, a misdemeanor, and (ii) MCL 750.505 Common Law Offense- Misconduct in Office, a felony punishable for not more than five years, by jury verdict of guilty

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Commission is required to revoke Petitioner's Law Enforcement Officer License under subsection 9(12)(c) of the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards Act.

IT IS ORDERED THAT Petitioner's Law Enforcement Officer License is revoked, effective on the date below.
