Michigan's licensing examination for law enforcement officers focuses on the objectives published in the Basic Training Curriculum and Training Objectives. Each objective was covered during your training academy experience. Therefore, remember to use textbooks, handouts, class notes, practical problems, and other resources acquired during your academy training to ensure that you have a clear understanding of each objective.

Because there are multiple versions of the examination, you will receive a different version of the examination when you retest. But keep in mind that the retest will be of equal difficulty, the structure and format of the questions will remain the same, the time limit is the same, and there will be an identical number of questions for you to answer. As is the case with the initial examination, there are no trick questions on the retest.

Prior to taking the retest, sleep well the night before, eat a light breakfast and try to relax. Cramming just prior to the examination is usually counterproductive. The licensing examination does not require you to memorize specific names, dates, or numbers associated with legal citations. Therefore, focus on applying knowledge to the situations posed in the questions.

Remember, *preparation* is your roadmap to success.

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
