**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

Upon reviewing the record of the administrative proceedings in this matter, the Commission finds as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Petitioner is or has been licensed as a law enforcement officer in Michigan.
2. Petitioner was subjected to an adjudication of guilt, by plea of guilty to Fleeing and Eluding, fourth-degree, a four-year felony under MCL 750.479a, in conjunction with assignment to youthful trainee status under the Holmes Youthful Trainee Act, MCL 762.11, in the Seventh Judicial Circuit Court, Genesee County, Michigan.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

The Commission is required to revoke Petitioner's Law Enforcement Officer License under subsection (2)(a)(iv) and 9(12)(c) of the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards Act.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** Petitioner's Law Enforcement Officer License is revoked, effective on the date below.
