**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

Upon reviewing the record of the administrative proceedings in this matter, the Commission finds as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Petitioner is or has been licensed as a law enforcement officer in Michigan.
2. Petitioner was subjected to an adjudication of guilt for an offense specified in U.S. Code of Federal Regulations 18 U.S.C. § 1951(a) Extortion, a felony punishable for not more than twenty years, by entry of a plea of guilty.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

The Commission is required to revoke Petitioner's Law Enforcement Officer License under subsection 9(12)(c) of the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards Act.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** Petitioner's Law Enforcement Officer License is revoked, effective on the date below.
