


Traditional Hay Storage




Reduced Risk Hay Storage




Hoop Barn/Feed Security Structures

Challenges

Most producers operate on limited resources

- Making changes to meet WRMP Standards can be costly
- Producers are directed to apply for assistance through NRCS

Access to Farm Bill funding is difficult

- NRCS - EQIP practices are available, but *not accessible*
- Applications only addressing TB-related issues unlikely to get funded

Separate Pool of Funding Needed

- WRMP applicants compete with all other producers in their area
- Cooperative Conservation Partnership Initiative (CCPI) proposal unsuccessful
