**WHEREAS**, the Knapp Intercounty Drain Drainage Board met on March 30, 2016 to consider the petition, dated February 1, 2016, for maintenance and improvement of an intercounty drain pursuant to Chapter 8 of Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, to determine the sufficiency of signatures on the petition, go over the route of the intercounty drain, and to further determine whether the maintenance and improvement of the intercounty drain is practicable; and

**WHEREAS**, said Drainage Board after hearing the evidence offered made its determination upon the sufficiency of signatures on the petition and whether the proposed drain project is practicable.
