Licensing applications are due at least 30 days prior to occupancy. Please submit your application as soon as possible to allow a timely inspection. Please note that license application fees are nonrefundable.

- 1) Under **Unit Number ID**: Provide a unit number if known.
- 2) Under License Applicant Information: Provide your contact information, address, phone number and Email.
- 3) Under **Migrant Labor Housing Location**: Provide camp address, county, township and section number and intended opening date, if known.
- 4) Under Living Units Type: Check the type of housing available for licensing and the number of units for each type of units.
- 5) Under **Total Square Footage**: Provide the area of the building based on exterior measurements. A 20x80 mobile home unit is 1600 sq. ft.
- 6) Under **Capacity**: Provide the number of occupants in each unit. This is based on the square footage divided by 100.
 - a. Example 1: A 20x80 mobile home unit is 1600 sq. ft. Capacity is 1600/100 = 16 people.
 - b. Example 2: A 30x71 mobile unit is 2130/100= 21 people. (Rounding Down)
 - c. For a 2 story home occupied on both levels, the total square footage is calculated by multiplying the house area (based on exterior dimensions) by 2
- 7) Check **H2A** box if you are expecting to use the H2A guest workers program for your labor needs.
- 8) The total application fee for all units is based on \$5.00 Dollars for each 100 square feet of housing. Write the actual dollar amount you send in the <u>Amount Enclosed</u> box.
- 9) Sign, date and print name in the boxes shown. Send your check or money order, payable to the **State of Michigan** and mail with your completed application in the enclosed pre-addressed envelope [Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development P.O. Box 30776, Lansing, MI 48909].

Once your application has been submitted:

- Prepare your camp for licensure.
- Contact your inspector to schedule a licensing inspection at least 30 days prior to anticipated occupancy.
- Conduct a self-assessment of each living unit and structure in your camp(s) using the pre-inspection worksheet which can be downloaded from www.michigan.gov/mlh.
- Submit your water samples for analysis. A license will not be issued without satisfactory water sample results.

Note: Licenses can only be issued if:

- 1) an inspection has been completed with a full or temporary license recommendation
- 2) satisfactory Bacteriological and Nitrate water samples have been received
- 3) application and fee have been processed
