**Applicant:**  
To improve knowledge of the proper care of animals pursuant to state animal anticruelty laws by educating the public, to include the purchase of equipment and supplied for this program.

*Michigan Penal Code, Act 328 of 1931, Chapter IX Animals, Section 50 provides that an owner, possessor, or person having the charge or custody of animal must provide an animal with adequate care. "Animal means any vertebrate other than a human and "adequate care" means the provision of sufficient food, water, shelter, sanitary conditions, exercise and veterinary medical attention in order to maintain an animal in a state of good health. "State of good health" means freedom from disease and illness, and in a condition of proper body weight and temperature for the age and species of the animal, unless the animal is undergoing appropriate treatment.*
