## Notice of Letting and Day of Review of Apportionments

### COUNTY LINE INTERCOUNTY DRAIN (Isabella and Gratiot Counties)

#### NOTICE OF LETTING

The County Line Intercounty Drain Drainage Board will meet on the above date, time and location to receive construction bids for the County Line Intercounty Drain. Bids will then be opened and publicly announced.

The County Line Intercounty Drain will be let in one section as follows, having the length, average depth and width as set forth:

***Install 16,505 lineal feet of perforated dual-wall high-density polyethylene (HDPE) drain tile with sock as follows: 2,182 lineal feet of 36-inch diameter with an average depth of 5.4 feet; 2,255 lineal feet of 24-inch diameter with an average depth of 4.9 feet; 7,237 lineal feet of 18-inch diameter with an average depth of 7.5 feet; 2,505 lineal feet of 15-inch diameter with an average depth of 5.8 feet; 1,577 lineal feet of 12-inch diameter with an average depth of 5.8 feet; 749 lineal feet of 8-inch diameter with an average depth of 3.8 feet. Install one 7-foot diameter catch basin, two 5-foot diameter catch basins, eight 4-foot diameter catch basins, seven 3-foot diameter catch basins, and eight 2-foot diameter catch basins. Install agri-drain bar grates on all catch basins. Install inserta-tee connections as necessary to connect field tiles.***

This Notice of Letting, the plans, specifications and bid proposal shall be considered a part of the Contract. A **mandatory pre-bid conference** will be held at **9:00 a.m. on September 20, 2016** at the **Isabella County Building, Room 225**. The Contract will be let in accordance with the Contract Documents now on file at the offices of the Isabella and Gratiot County Drain Commissioners and available to interested parties. Bids will be made and received in accordance with these documents. Bidding Documents, including plans and specifications, may be examined at the following locations:

***Isabella County Drain Commissioner's office; Gratiot County Drain Commissioner's office.***

Copies of Bidding Documents may only be obtained upon payment of a \$100.00 ***non-refundable*** deposit. Electronic copies of Bidding Documents may be obtained upon payment of a \$25.00 ***non-refundable*** deposit.

A security deposit in the form of a cashier's check, money order, certified check or bidders bond shall be submitted with any bids. No cash will be permitted. The security deposits of all unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after the Contract is awarded.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders. The Contract completion date and the terms of payment will be announced at the time and place of letting. If no satisfactory bids are received, we reserve the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn to a time and location as we shall announce.

The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the tentative apportionment of benefit for each parcel and municipality within the Intercounty Drainage District.

The Drain Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day, and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Intercounty Drain will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Drain Commissioner of their County at the number listed above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

You may appeal the Drain Commissioner's determination of apportionments to the Probate Court in the county in which you reside within ten (10) days.

The following is a description of the several tracts or parcels of lands constituting the Special Assessment District of the County Line Intercounty Drain, as well as a list of any county, township, city, village to be assessed at large:

***Part of the Southeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 36; Town 13 North and Range 4 West, Lincoln Township, Isabella County. Portions of the Northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  and of the South  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 31, and also part of the West  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 32; Town 13 North and Range 3 West, Coe Township, Isabella***

**County. Part of the East ½ of Section 1, and part of the Northwest ¼ of the Northeast ¼ of Section 12; Town 12 North and Range 4 West, Seville Township, Gratiot County. Portions of the North ½ of the Southwest ¼, the Northwest ¼, and the North ½ of the Southeast ¼ of Section 6, and also part of the Northwest ¼ of the Northwest ¼ of Section 5; Town 12 North and Range 3 West, Pine River Township, Gratiot County, Michigan.**

**Isabella County for benefits to public roads; Coe Township and Lincoln Township at large for benefits to public health, convenience and welfare.**

**Gratiot County for benefits to public roads; Seville Township and Pine River Township at large for benefits to public health, convenience and welfare.**
