## Notice of Drainage Board Meeting for the Determination of Practicability

### STANTON INTERCOUNTY DRAIN

**Notice is hereby given**, that a petition dated December 21, 2015 was filed with Brian Wendling, Saginaw County Public Works Commissioner, praying for the maintaining and improving of a drain known and designated as the Stanton Intercounty Drain pursuant to Chapter 8 of the Drain Code, P.A. 40 of 1956, as amended.

**Whereas**, the Drainage District for the Stanton Intercounty Drain includes lands within the following counties and their respective municipalities: Midland County: Mount Haley, and Saginaw County: Jonesfield Township, and

**Whereas**, a certified copy of said petition was served upon Douglas Enos, Midland County Drain Commissioner; and Jamie Clover Adams, Director of the Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development; by Brian Wendling, Saginaw County Public Works Commissioner.

**Now therefore**, in accordance with P.A. 40, of 1956, as amended, a Drainage Board meeting of the Stanton Intercounty Drain will be held on **March 4, 2016**, at 10:30 a.m., at the **Jonesfield Township Hall, 217 Eddy Street** in the **Village of Merrill**, County of Saginaw, to determine the practicability of said petition.

**Now therefore**, all persons owning lands liable to an assessment for benefits, or whose lands will be crossed by said drain, or any municipality affected, are requested to be present at said meeting, if they so desire. Public comment will be received at the meeting. Proceedings conducted at this public meeting will be subject to the provisions of the Michigan Open Meetings Act. Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the meeting should contact the Drain/Public Works Commissioner of their county at the number listed below or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.
