Subject: WARN Act Notice

Please be advised that this communication is being provided pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act. This letter is to advise you that a "mass layoff" as defined by the Act will take place at the Ford Dearborn Truck Plant located at 3001 Miller Road, Dearborn, MI 48120.

It is anticipated that approximately 828 hourly employees will be affected by the "mass layoff" on or about September 22, 2008 when operations will be reduced from 3 shifts of production to 2 shifts of production. This "mass layoff" will be indefinite. The number of affected employees by classification as outlined in this letter may be less due to the anticipation of potential attrition e.g., transfers, voluntary quits, retirements, etc., between now and the effective date of this action.


