Dear Ms. Hennessey:

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that Visteon Corporation will be permanently terminating the employment of approximately 137 UAW Local 849 employees and 23 non-represented employees who are presently leased to Automotive Components Holdings, LLC ("ACH") and work at ACH's Plant located at 128 Spring Street, Ypsilanti, Michigan 48197. The termination is due to ACH's recent notification to Visteon that it will no longer require the services of these employees based upon ACH's decision to close its Ypsilanti Plant.

The enclosed list provides the job titles and number of affected employees in each job classification and their anticipated date of separation. These reductions may be affected in the interim by a number of factors such as voluntary quits, retirements and other changes to the workforce. For the approximately 23 non-represented employees, bumping rights do not exist. The approximately 137 hourly employees affected by this action are represented by UAW Local 849. The Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Company and UAW Local 849 provides a method for such reductions in the workforce and as such bumping rights exist for these employees. It is anticipated that these employees will be impacted by this action as indicated on the enclosed list. With respect to the employees scheduled to be impacted before October 7, 2008, ACH's notification to Visteon Corporation that it would be releasing these employees on the dates indicated was unforeseeable, without prior notice and outside Visteon's control.
