**ARAMARK – Benton Harbor Area Schools Food Services**

Dear Mayor Cook:

On July 25, 2006, ARAMARK School Support Services was informed that it would not be retained to provide food services for the Benton Harbor Area School District. As a result, ARAMARK will permanently close its operations at Benton Harbor Area Schools, 373 S. Fair, Benton Harbor 49022, on August 18, 2006 and permanently terminate the employment of its employees assigned to duty at such facility on such date.

Accordingly, I am sending you this notice to satisfy the requirements of the Federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (“WARN”) Act, 29 U.S.C. § 2101 et seq. While we have not determined that WARN is applicable to this closing, we are providing this notice in the event WARN is deemed to apply.

1. As a result of the closing described above, ARAMARK expects to permanently terminate its employees at Benton Harbor Area Schools.
2. The specific job titles of our employees affected by this facility closing, as well as the number of our employees in each job classification, are listed on the attachment to this notice.
3. There are no bumping rights applicable to these employees.
