Dear Ms. Hennessey:

Woodhaven-Brownstone School District ("Woodhaven-Brownstone") notified ARAMARK Educational Services, LLC ("ARAMARK") that it would not renew its contract with ARAMARK and that ARAMARK must permanently cease its operations at Woodhaven-Brownstone on June 14, 2007. As a result, ARAMARK must permanently terminate the employment of its employees assigned to duty at such facility on such date. Accordingly, we will cease to provide its services at Woodhaven-Brownstone on June 14, 2007.

Accordingly, I am sending you this notice to satisfy the requirements of the Federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification ("WARN") Act, 29 U.S.C. § 2101 et seq. While we have not determined that WARN is applicable to this closing, we are providing this notice in the event WARN is deemed to apply.
