Mr. James Houck:

The purpose of this letter is to provide notification as required by The Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act, 29USC 2101, et seq.

Ampco System Parking ("Ampco") holds a contract to provide parking services to the Wayne County Airport Authority. Ampco employs approximately 142 people under the Airport contract. That contract expires August 31, 2003. The Airport Authority has advised Ampco that the contract will be put out for competitive bid in the very near future. Ampco may or may not be awarded a new contract. If Ampco is not awarded a new contract by the Airport Authority, the result will be that 100% of our employees working under the Airport Authority contract will be terminated from their employment with Ampco as of the close of business August 31, 2003. It is possible that Ampco will be awarded the new contract by the Airport Authority; however we are providing this notice to you 60 days in advance of August 31, so that you will be aware that a large-scale termination of employment is a possibility. If we receive information which clarifies the situation one way or the other, we will notify you again as quickly as possible.



The purpose of this letter is to provide notification as required by The Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act, 29 USC 2101, et seq.

This letter is supplemental to the notification previously provided to you on June 30, 2003

Ampco System Parking ("Ampco") holds a contract to provide parking services to the Wayne County Airport Authority. Ampco employs approximately 137 people under the Airport contract. That contract expires August 31, 2003. We sent our previous notification because we were uncertain whether our contract would be renewed or termination on August 31.

Unfortunately, the Airport has now formally notified Ampco System Parking that our contract will terminate on August 31, 2003. The result of this decision will be that 100% of our employees working under the Airport Authority contract will be terminated from their employment with Ampco as of the close of business August 31, 2003.
