Mr. James Houck:

The purpose of this letter is to provide notification as required by The Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act, 29USC 2101, et seq.

Due to business downturns resulting from September 11, 2001, recently announced contract changes by our customer, and the opening of the Edward H. McNamara Terminal/Northwest World Gateway, Ampco System Parking will be reducing its workforce at the Detroit Metropolitan Airport. We do not know the final number of employees who could be affected, however it is possible that the number will range between 85 to 100 employees, and constitute 33% of our workforce at the airport.


