CSX Transportation, Inc. ("CSXT") hereby provides notice pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN), 29 U.S.C. Sec. 2101 et. seq., of a plant closing at its terminal located in Saginaw, Michigan. This action is expected to occur within a 14-day period beginning on October 28, 2005. This closing should be considered permanent and is due to a long-term lease and purchase of approximately 67 miles of rail line to Saginaw Bay Southern Railway Company pursuant to Section 10901 of the Interstate Commerce Act. In total, approximately 124 positions at this location will be eliminated.

All of the affected employees except one Roadmaster are covered by collective bargaining agreements. Some of these represented employees will have the opportunity based upon their seniority to obtain other positions with CSXT at other facilities within the area. Relocation benefits will be provided under the applicable labor agreements.
