In accordance with the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act ("WARN"), we regret to inform you that Cattleman's Meat Company will be implementing a mass lay-off at our operations located at 1825 Scott Street, Detroit, Michigan 48207 due to a change in the nature of our business operations. We anticipate a major reduction in plant operations starting January 1, 2007. The contact at the Company is David Rohtbart (telephone number 313-833-2700). This mass lay-off will affect approximately 100 union and non-union employees. Bumping rights do exist for the union employees. The United Food and Commercial Workers Union, Local 876, represents approximately 105 hourly workers at the facility.
