This Notice is being submitted to you and the other parties required to be notified, as reflected below, in accordance with the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act ("WARN").

You and they are hereby informed that Centennial HealthCare Management Corporation intends to cease operations at the facilities located at the following addresses:

(Oakland County)

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This cessation of operations will cause all Centennial Employee Management Corporation ("CEMC") employees at this facility to be permanently laid off from employment with CEMC. This cessation of operations and the resulting layoffs are expected to take place between March 31, 2003 and April 14, 2003. There is reason to be hopeful that this facility will transition to a new operator/manager without any interruption in services. In that event, it is possible that the new operator/manager will offer employment to some or all individuals who have worked at the facility.

The affected employees at the Charter House of Novi facility are not represented by a union. Some of the employees at the Charter House of Farmington Hills facility are represented by Service Employees' International Union, Local 79:




