Dear Section Chief Hennessey:

Pursuant to the Worker Adjustment Retraining Notification (the "Act"), and for purposes limited to the Act only, notice is hereby given. Due to declining market conditions, Chrysler will suspend certain operations at the Sterling Heights Assembly Plant, located at 38111 Van Dyke Sterling Heights, Michigan 48312, on or about January 31, 2008. As a result, approximately 1,137 union-represented hourly employees, and 9 union-represented salary employees will be affected on or about January 31, 2008. In addition, non-bargaining unit employees may be impacted by these actions.

Most employees will have supplemental wage and fringe benefit programs, job placement and other work opportunity options available to them through applicable collective bargaining agreements and/or company sponsored programs.
