Dear Ms. Hennessey:

Pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 (the "WARN Act"), please be advised that Collins & Aikman Corporation (with its subsidiaries, the "Company") expects to permanently cease all operations and close its Port Huron facility located at 2100 Dove St., Port Huron, MI, on or by March 3, 2007. The entire plant will be closed. Notice has been provided today to all employees.

The Company expects permanent layoffs to occur on or by March 3, 2007. There are bumping rights. There is a union at this facility. (UAW 9699, 6038 Marlette Rd., PO Box 3555, Marlette, MI 48453) The Company is aware that under WARN it is required to provide 60 days notice of the closing starting with today's date. If layoffs are implemented before March 3, 2007, affected employees will continue to receive their regular base pay and benefits from the date employment is terminated through March 3, 2007, so that they will receive the equivalent of 60 days pay and benefits from today's date.

Dear Ms. Hennessey:

This notice is being issued pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 (the "WARN Act"), and supplements a WARN notice provided to you on January 2, 2007. As previously explained, due to financial circumstances of Collins & Aikman Corporation (with its subsidiaries, the "Company"), the Company expects to incur a significant reduction in the workforce in connection with the permanent cessation of all operations at its Port Huron facility at 2100 Dove Street. Based on recent developments the Company is now able to predict with reasonable certainty that the Port Huron operations will be shut down by July 27, 2007. Notice has been provided today to all employees.

The Company expects permanent layoffs to occur on or by July 27, 2007. There are no "bumping," transfer or reassignment rights. There is a union at this facility. UAW Local 9699, address is 6038 Marlette Rd., P.O. Box 3555, Marlette, MI 48453. Of course earlier layoffs are possible due to circumstances beyond the Company's control and information about any such layoffs will be provided as it becomes available.

Re: Supplemental WARN Act Notice

Dear Ms. Hennessey:

On January 2, 2007, your office was notified pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification ("WARN") Act of the pending closure of the Collins & Aikman Corporation's Port Huron facility. Then on March 2, 2007 you were advised that the Company is now able to predict with reasonable certainty that the Port Huron plant operations will be shut down on July 27, 2007. The purpose of this supplemental notice is to advise you of the specific dates that layoffs are now expected to occur. Such dates have not been communicated earlier because the Company has been unable until now to reasonably estimate the layoff schedule at this facility.

The attached exhibits reflect the dates' layoffs are expected to begin, as well as a schedule of future layoffs to the extent they can reasonably be predicted at this time. Also reflected on the exhibit are the job titles of positions to be affected, and the number of affected employees in each job classification. Additional information will be supplied as required by law.
