Pursuant to the Worker Adjustment Retraining Notification (the "Act"), and for purposes limited to the Act, notice is hereby given that, due to declining market conditions, DaimlerChrysler Corporation's World Headquarters and CTC facilities, located at 1000 Chrysler Drive, Auburn Hills, Michigan 48326 will layoff approximately 770 salaried, non-union-represented employees commencing on or about March 31, 2001.

Additionally, approximately 27 salaried, non-union represented employees at DaimlerChrysler's Jefferson North Assembly Plant, located at 2101 Conner Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48215, will be indefinitely laid off effective March 31, 2001.
