Dear Mr. Houck:

Pursuant to the Worker Adjustment Retraining Notification (the "Act"), and for purposes limited to the Act only, notice is hereby given that current manufacturing of glass products for the Chrysler Group vehicles will end on or about November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2003 at McGraw Glass plant, located at 9400 McGraw, Detroit, Michigan, 48210 and the plant will be deactivated. The affected UAW represented employees will be placed on company sponsored programs prior to 11/28/03. This is a permanent action on the part of the company. As a result, approximately 591 union-represented hourly employees, 28 union-represented salary employees, and 29 non-bargaining unit employees will be affected on or about November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2003.

Most employees will have supplemental wage and fringe benefit programs; job placement and other work opportunity options available to them through applicable collective bargaining agreements and/or company sponsored programs.


