Dear Labor and Economic Growth Agency:

Please be advised that Electronic Data Systems Corporation (EDS) has initiated a workforce reduction at our facility located at 1350 John R in Troy, MI. This activity is due to the loss of our OnStar contract. Because it was possible that as many as 426 employees could have been affected, notice was provided to employees in accordance with the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (Public Law 100-379). While some separations are still expected to occur by July 11, 2004, we are happy to report that the actual number of individuals to be affected will be far less than what was originally anticipated. Specifically, in cooperation with the successor contractor, EDS has been able to help secure continued employment for 345 of the 426 notified individuals. It is possible the final number of affected individuals may be further reduced as notified employees have the opportunity to apply for internal job openings up until the date of separation. None of the employees which may be affected are represented by a union nor do they have any bumping rights. An amplification of those originally given notice and those who may still experience an employment loss is as follows:
