RE: Notice Pursuant to The Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988

Dear Ms. Canfora:

We are providing this notice to satisfy the requirements of The Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988, 29 U.S.C. § 2101 et seq. ("WARN"), a law which requires advance written notice of certain layoffs and closings.

Due to the economic climate and a change to print publication on less than a daily basis, The Flint Journal, located at 200 E. First Street Flint, MI 48502, will be terminating 82 of its full and part time employees.

The layoff will commence on, or within 14 days of, May 25, 2009.


