Subject: Notice of Mass Layoff Pursuant to the W.A.R.N. Act

Pursuant to the "Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act" (W.A.R.N.) you are hereby notified of a planned employment loss in the form of a mass layoff as defined by the W.A.R.N. Act, at General Motors, Pontiac Assembly Plant located in Pontiac, Michigan.

Specifically, it is anticipated that second shift will cease production and be eliminated on June 27, 2008. As a result of the cessation of second shift a layoff will begin on July 14, 2008. The elimination of second shift will result in the permanent layoff of 1167 hourly employees represented by the U.A.W International Union, Ron Gettelfinger, President, 8000 East Jefferson, Detroit Michigan 48214. The currently anticipated job classifications and numbers of employees to be laid off are attached.

Employees laid off by this action may be eligible to receive State Unemployment Compensation and/or Supplemental Unemployment Benefits in accordance with Exhibit "D" to the Agreement between General Motors Corporation and the UAW dated October 15, 2007.

Subject: Notice of Mass Layoff Pursuant to the W.A.R.N. Act

RAPID RESPONSE
 WORKFORCE PROGRAMS

Pursuant to the "Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act" (W.A.R.N.) you are hereby notified of a planned employment loss in the form of a mass layoff as defined by the W.A.R.N. Act, at General Motors, Pontiac Assembly Plant located in Pontiac, Michigan.

Specifically, it is anticipated that a mass layoff due to a production line rate reduction will become effective on or about January 5, 2009. The mass layoff will result in the indefinite layoff of approximately 645 hourly employees represented by the U.A.W., International Union. Additionally, approximately 37 non-represented salary employees will be subject to re-assignment within General Motors or if no re-assignment is available will be eligible for severance benefits as determined by Corporate policy. The hourly job classifications and approximate associated numbers as well as the salary job titles anticipated to be laid off are attached.

For hourly employees, bumping rights do exist under the local collective bargaining agreement; for salaried employees, no bumping rights exist. Hourly employees laid off by this action may be eligible to receive State Unemployment Compensation and/or Supplemental Unemployment Benefits in accordance with Exhibit "D" to the Agreement between General Motors Corporation and the U.A.W. dated October 15, 2007. Salary employees, whose employment is involuntarily terminated, will receive severance benefits if otherwise eligible (including per diem employees with insufficient seniority to hold the local bargaining unit) and/or State Unemployment Compensation Benefits.
