Dear Ms. Hennessey:

Please be advised that, on or around July 30, 2006, Johnson Controls, Inc. will permanently close its Mt. Clemens facility located at 126 North Groesbeck Highway, Mt. Clemens, Michigan 48043. The terminations of the affected employees will occur in two waves. Consistent with these plans, the last day of employment for all affected employees is anticipated to be either May 19, 2006 (or within two weeks thereafter) or July 28, 2006 (or within two weeks thereafter). The plant closing will be permanent.

A list of the affected job classifications and number of employees per classification is attached. Some of these employees are represented by UAW Local 9699; however, no bumping rights will exist following the plant closing. All terminated employees will be paid all earned wages and agreed-upon fringe benefits upon termination.
