*Notice for Site Closing/Loss Of Work With Respect To
275 Rex Boulevard, Auburn Hills, MI Facility*

Dear Ms. Hennessey:

Please be advised that MSXI has decided to permanently suspend the operations that were being performed at its Rex Blvd location effective December 31, 2006. Most employees working at its Rex Blvd facility will work until just prior to year-end (between December 23, 2006 and December 31, 2006).

There is one operation (the tooling and fixture operation), however, that will wind down prior to the rest of the operations. The tooling and fixture employees were notified on October 16, 2006 that their particular operation would be wound down by early December. Because MSXI anticipates the permanent suspension of all operations at the facility, all positions and jobs at the Rex Blvd worksite will be eliminated.

It is anticipated that 62 employees will be affected by the above-referenced closure. Attached is a list of the affected positions and the number of employees holding each position. Affected employees do not have bumping rights. Most of the affected employees are represented by the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, AFL-CIO, Warren Local Lodge PM 2848. John Winterhalter is the chief elected officer of the Union and he has been notified on this date.


