Re: Mayco Layoff- Bargaining Unit Employees

Dear Ms. Hennessey:

As set forth in the attached chart, Mayco Plastics, Inc. ("Mayco") is terminating operations at its facility located at 42400 Merrill, Sterling Heights, Michigan 48314. While Mayco continues to seek a buyer who might continue some or all of its operations, whether a buyer will be found is uncertain. Therefore, Mayco will effectuate permanent layoffs at this facility due to faltering business conditions and unforeseen business circumstances. As such, we are providing you this notice containing information required by the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act, 29 U.S.C. §2102(a).


The layoff will occur at Mayco's facility located at 42400 Merrill, Sterling Heights, Michigan 48314. The layoff process will be staggered and is expected to result in the permanent layoff of approximately 383 bargaining unit employees on November 3, 2006 or within two weeks thereafter, on or before November 17, 2006. Regardless of the date of termination, however, it is Mayco's intention to continue such employees' regular compensation and health benefits as required by the collective bargaining agreement or as otherwise provided by law.

Mayco employs workers who are members of the International Union, United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America ("UAW") and its Local Number 155. The layoff of union employees and the exercising of "bumping rights" will be in accordance with the current collective bargaining agreement. The attached list reflects the job title of bargaining unit employees' positions affected and the number of affected employees in each job classification.
