
Re: Metaldyne Livonia Plant Closing

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to inform you that Metaldyne has decided that the entire plant facility located at 12215 Market St. Livonia, MI. 48150 will be closed. This letter is the formal plant closing notice required by federal law. The plant is being closed because of strategic restructuring within Metaldyne; a decision has been reached that the machining operations at Livonia, Michigan will be consolidated with other within other Metaldyne facilities.

Precise timing for the closure has not yet been set, but the gradual phase out of the operations will begin on or about April 26, 2002 with an anticipated completion by August 2002.

Approximately 24 employees will permanently lose their jobs. There is no union representation at this plant. Please direct any questions to Bob Field, HR Director, 847-647-2485.
