
Dear Ms. Wilbur:

On May 22, 2002 FORD Motor Company informed us (Newcor Inc.) that in October of 2001 they had made an internal decision to resource the machining of the Ford Oil Pump Transmission Shaft from Newcor Technologies facility to AIKOKU, a Japanese company. The last date scheduled for production at the Technologies facility is July 31, 2001. This move results in the loss of approximately 40 jobs.
