Dear Ms. Hennessey:

This notice is provided to you in accordance with the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988, 29 U.S.C. § 2101 *et seq.*

Due to a recent sudden and permanent loss of our largest customers and substantially all of our business, management of OLP, LLC d/b/a Olympic Laser Processing (“OLP”) has tentatively made the decision, subject to the approval of the Board of OLP, to permanently discontinue operations and to close the plant located at 6331 Schooner Drive, Belleville, Michigan, 48111. We regret these unfortunate circumstances.

Approximately 92 employees, which constitutes all job titles and positions, union and non-union, are expected to be affected by the plant closing and bumping rights will not be applicable. A list of the affected positions is attached. It is anticipated that, if the Board approves, the plant shutdown will occur no earlier than March 15, 2006, or within fourteen (14) days thereafter. The exact date will be established as it becomes available.
