
**Re: Notification Under Worker Adjustment
and Retraining Notification Act (WARN)**

This notice is provided as required by the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 (WARN Act) and constitutes notice to the State of Michigan and the chief elected officials of applicable local governments of Pall Corporation's intent to permanently close its Ann Arbor, Michigan manufacturing facility located in Scio Township and Washtenaw County at 600 South Wagner Road.

The Company anticipates closing the facility on or about June 1, 2007. The Company will begin laying off a limited number of individuals on or about August 23, 2006 and will continue to layoff employees until closing the Ann Arbor facility. In total, the Company permanently will lay off approximately 270 employees. The employees have no bumping rights and are not represented by a union.
