

The expected date of the commencement of initial layoffs associated with the closing is September 2, 2005 and the closure is expected to be complete by October 31, 2005. It is anticipated that there will be additional layoffs due to the phased loss of business on October 1, 2005, October 15, 2005, and October 31, 2005.

In addition to the above there will be some employees laid off due to the loss of business at Tee-Mar's facility located at 16150 Grove Road, Lansing, Michigan, 48906 (known as the Tee-Mar Lansing 3 facility) commencing September 2, 2005.



Dear Ms. Hennessey:

To the extent the Worker Adjustment Retraining and Notification Act ("WARN Act") may be deemed to apply, this letter will formally notify you that Tec-Mar Distribution Services, Inc. Intends to layoff six people by November 15, 2005. This layoff is in conjunction with the permanent cessation of operations and the closure of the entire manufacturing facility located at 3400 North Grand River, Lansing, Michigan, 48906 (known as the "Tec-Mar Lansing 2 facility").

My letter of June 29, 2005 to you indicated that the expected date of the commencement of initial layoffs associated with the closing is September 2, 2005 and the closure was expected to be complete by October 31, 2005. It was anticipated that there would be additional layoffs due to the phased loss of business on October 1, 2005, October 15, 2005, and October 31, 2005.

As a result of changes made by General Motors to its transition plan, three commodities will not be moved until November 15, 2005. This will result in a delay of termination of employment for six employees until that date. I am providing this notification not because additional employees are being terminated but rather to the extent, as to the six terminations identified herein, an additional notification may be required by the WARN Act. 


