
De-duplicating Chronic Hepatitis B Reports in the MDSS



Notes

- Electronic Lab Reports (ELRs) for hepatitis B virus (HBV) are generally reported in MDSS as **Hepatitis B**, **Acute**. Please review the *Reportable Condition* to make sure it is accurate. For more information refer to the "Hepatitis B Reporting Flowchart".
- Acute Hepatitis B for women of childbearing age (10-60 years)
 would also need to have pregnancy status confirmed. If
 pregnant, these women also need to be reported to the
 PHBPP.

- 1. Notify the MDCH Perinatal Hepatitis E Prevention Program (PHBPP).
- 2. If newly reported, determine appropriate *Case Status* and mark the *Investigation Status* as **Completed.**
- 3. If previously reported, merge the patient, but create a **New Case** and mark *the Investigation Status* as **Superceded.**
