

STATUS OF THE RATE DEVELOPMENT AND NUMBER OF DUAL ELIGIBLES ENROLLED BY MONTH IN MEDICAID HEALTH PLANS

(FY2011 Appropriation Bill - Public Act 187 of 2010)

February 28, 2011

Section 1783: (1) The department shall develop rates by April 1 of the current fiscal year for the enrollment of individuals dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid into Medicaid health plans if those health plans also maintain a Medicare advantage special needs plan certified by the centers for Medicare and Medicaid services. (2) The department shall report quarterly to the house and senate appropriations subcommittees on community health and to the house and senate fiscal agencies the status of the rate development described in subsection (1) and the number of dual eligibles enrolled by month in Medicaid health plans with Medicare advantage special needs plan certification for the current fiscal year.

FY2011 Boilerplate Report - Section 1783(2)

This section requires that the department shall report quarterly on the status of rate development for rates for the enrollment of individuals dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid into Medicaid Health Plans if these plans also maintain a Medicare advantage special needs plan certified by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

Effective October 1 of 2011 (fiscal year 2012), the department will implement optional enrollment for persons dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid into all Medicaid health plans, including those plans which have been certified as Medicare advantage special needs plans by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. Rates are in the process of being developed for this population. Because enrollment of persons who are dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid will not begin until October 1, 2011, none are currently enrolled in Medicaid health plans.
