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Introduction


The Michigan Behavioral Risk Factor Survey (BRFS) is a statewide, random-digit dialed telephone survey of adult residents aged 18 years and older. State-specific, population-based prevalence estimates (and 95% confidence intervals) of health risk behaviors, preventive health practices, and chronic conditions are calculated using annual data sets (see Annual Tables at http://www.michigan.gov/brfs). However, region-specific and local health department-specific prevalence rates are usually computed using BRFS data combined across years.

For this report, data from the 2006 - 2008 Michigan BRFS were combined. The total sample sizes by year were: 9,447 in 2008, 7,505 in 2007, and 5,662 in 2006. Not all questions were included annually in the survey. The table subtitles indicate which years were used for that particular analysis.

Estimates have been weighted to adjust for the probabilities of selection and the distribution of Michigan adults by age, sex, and race-ethnicity at the state level. Final annual analysis weights were used; no additional weighting factors have been computed for the regional or local health department level. These analyses were performed in SUDAAN, a statistical computing program that was designed for complex sample surveys. Estimates are reported for geographic subgroups with a sample size of at least 50 respondents.
