Keynote Speaker - *National Perspective on Regulatory Efforts to Contain Cost, Assure Quality & Improve Access*

Paul Parker is the Chief for Hospital Services Planning & Policy, and for CON at the Maryland Health Care Commission. He also is a member of the Board of Directors of American Health Planning Association (AHPA). Mr. Parker has worked as a consultant to state governments, regional planning agencies, medical facilities, and physicians. He also directed Virginia's Certificate of Public Need Program at the Department of Health. He has over thirty years of experience in health planning, policy analysis, market feasibility research and corporate development, including work in the private sector for the Marriott Corporation and Basic American Medical Corporation. Mr. Parker holds two degrees from Indiana University, a B.A. in Political Science and an M.P.A. in Health Systems Administration from the School of Public and Environmental Affairs.

Special Breakout Session – *Learning Best Practices from Other State CON Models*

Christopher Delker is a Health Program Administrator in the New York State (NYS) Department of Health's Division of Health Facility Planning, where he is responsible for regulatory reform, analysis of emergent policy issues affecting the CON program, and administration of grants issued under Health Care Efficiency and Affordability Law to reduce excess bed capacity and strengthen ambulatory and community-based care. He holds a Bachelor's degree in history and a Master's degree in public affairs from the University of Texas at Austin.

Charles Abel directs the Financial Analysis and Review, Grants and Procurement, and Project Management bureaus of the NYS Department of Health's Division of Health Facility Planning. Mr. Abel is responsible for overseeing the financial analysis and project management functions of the CON program. He is responsible for the development and implementation of electronic CON initiative at NYS. He is also responsible for the financial review and monitoring of health facilities restructurings and closures per the mandates of The Commission on Health Care Facilities in the 21st Century. Mr. Abel has a Masters Degree in Public Administration from the State University of New York at Albany.

Erik Bodin has been the Director of the Virginia Department of Health's Division of Certificate of Public Need for nine years. Mr. Bodin has a Master of Science in Health Administration from the Virginia Commonwealth University Medical College of Virginia. He served as the Director of Planning at the Medical College of Virginia Hospitals when Certificate of Public Need came back in Virginia after a four year period of deregulation.





