


Three groups – the Michigan Food & Agriculture Protection and Defense Work Group, the Michigan Food Safety Alliance, and the Great Lakes Border Health Initiative – combined to conduct the 'Wilted Woes' scenario of the U.S Food & Drug Administration's Food Related Emergency Exercise – Bundle (FREE-B), with a total of 88 participants and 11 evaluators/observers/facilitators.



Participants were divided based on disciplines, for a total of 14 tables. The scenario was presented in two modules, and at the end of each, the work groups discussed questions specific to their roles, followed by brief report-outs.





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
